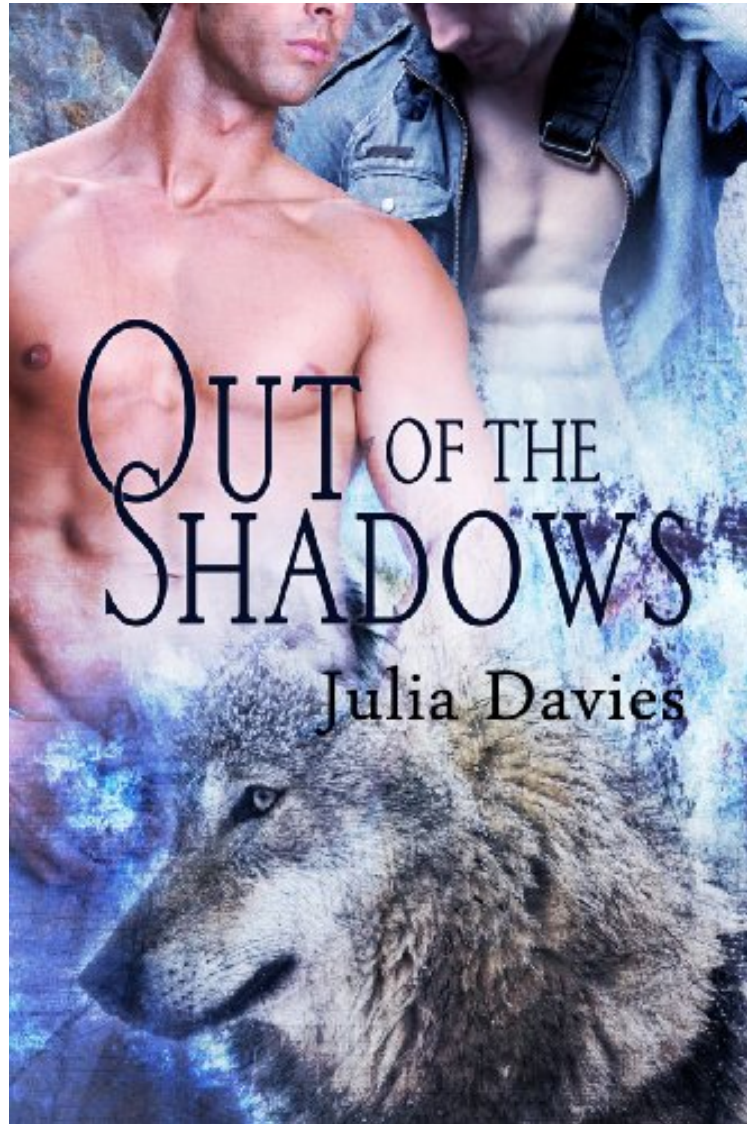

Lust in die Geschichte um Jai und Dane einzutauchen. Leider konnte mich der weitere Inhalt nicht berzeugen. Jai und Dane sind zwar sympathisch, allerdings hat es die Autorin für mich nicht geschafft die Beiden zum Leben zu erwecken. Man erfährt so gut wie nichts über ihr soziales Umfeld oder ihre Gefühlswelt. Wichtige Fragen, die das Buch lebendig gemacht hätten bleiben unbeantwortet (z.B. Jai erklärt Dane, dass er allein bei seinem Vater aufgewachsen ist warum?; keiner mochte den Freund von Danes Schwester warum? etc.) und auf den Aspekt Werwolf wird so gut wie gar nicht eingegangen. Gegen Ende des Buches kommt noch einmal Spannung auf, für mich allerdings zu spät um das Ganze noch interessant zu machen. Erotik: ***Es gibt eine Menge Sexszenen in Out of the Shadows und alle laufen (mit zwei Ausnahmen) nach dem gleichen Schema ab. Zwar sind sie nicht schlecht geschrieben, aber irgendwann habe ich die Abstände einfach bersprungen, da ich sowieso wusste wie es weitergeht.
