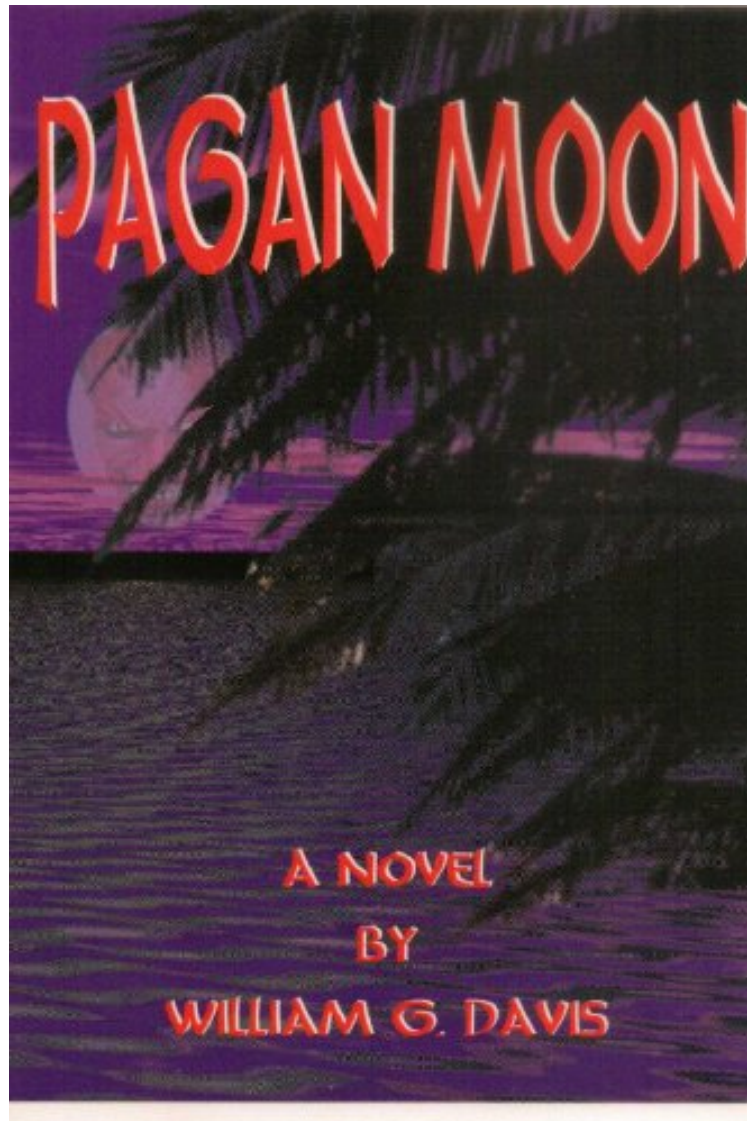

technical aspects of his craft; his style is fluent and compelling, errors are kept to a minimum, formatting is decent. If only it wasn't for a sub-zero plot that suffers heavily from homophobia, implausible procedures, two-dimensional characters, and an embarrassing lack of research (example: the protagonist claims he has researched satanic cults for about 20 years and has a collection of subject-related books at home - but he has never heard of Baphomet, let alone in context of the Knights Templar). What begins with a series of at first unrelated murders, transforms into much more, namely into a mission to save his girl plus the entire world, from a satanic Nazi cult, no less. Apparently it wasn't sufficient to make the antagonists Dutch/German/South African satanic Nazi-Templar serial killers; to drive his point home, the cult's bigwigs are also gay and HIV positive, "swishy" and "light in their loafers", to quote the author. That's not always easy to do in a field that's crowded with mystery/thrillers. In Pagan Moon I tried to do something different, writing about a cop who is forced to face the true face of evil in confronting the occult and supernatural. The seeds for Pagan Moon were planted some years ago when I read a book by Maury Terry, which I believe is now out of print. In it, he tried to draw a link between the Son of Sam murders and the existence of a nationwide satanic cult that led to some important people in the entertainment industry. The premise was so chilling that I decided to further explore the subject through several books, including Painted Black by Carl A. Raschke. If you want to read some really disturbing stuff about what's going on in this country, by all means read it. I tend to write about things that bother me, and that's how I finally sat down several years ago and began Pagan Moon. It took a period of years and some help to shape it into something that was publishable, but one thing I found was that it was never boring. Those who have read it say it's hard to put down. ...
