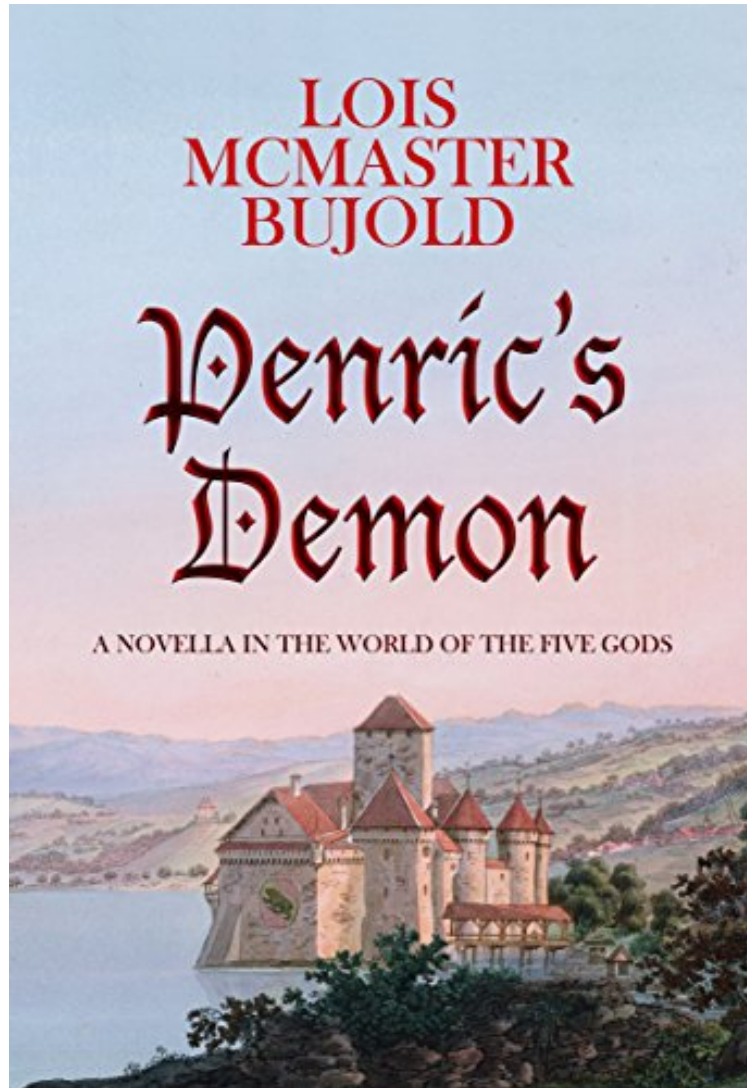

Obwohl die Erzählung nur relativ kurz ist und sich der Zeitrahmen auf wenige Wochen beschränkt, schafft es Bujold ihren Figuren eine Menge Leben einzuhauchen, dazu werden Land und Leute gut vorstellbar geschildert.
