It is classified as dark romance, but after the other dark stories I have recently read I would rate it as a light dark romance only: The darkness is always lurking beneath the surface and threatens to come out, but it rarely does it is the perfect book to dive into this kind of genre: You wont get overly shocked, but you get a glimpse into what kind of evil things could be

happening in a dark romance. Autumn is a teenage girl that lives on the streets and is struggling to survive day by day. Not only is she starving, she is also running away from somebody, refusing to be found. In her desperation she hands her life, her body, her soul over to an organization called Stroker. She knew that going to Stroker would mean selling herself everything is better than starving on the streets and eventually being found by someone who wants her dead, right? Well, maybe, if said organization would not prepare and educate those hopeless girl to be sold to the highest bidder as a slave, not infrequently as a sex slave. But instead being sold Autumn is sent to Tate, a man known as The Viper and feared even by men of the organization. Tate knows the organization well, was even a part of it at one time. He once has been a trainer of the girls, one of the men the best, actually to torture and to break them in order for them to learn how to submit to their prospective masters. But that is not who he is any longer, he changed. Now he fights his own demons and lives an isolated life in reclusion until he receives Autumn as a gift. Not knowing how to act around her, he tries to keep is distance from Autumn, to scare her away from him. Only Autumn is stubborn she doesnt back down easily and if anything, Tates harsh and slightly unfair treatment draws her closer to him. She knows she shouldnt feel this way, but simply cannot help her feelings and sooner or later even Tate is not able to deny their attraction towards one another any longer. This book has a light dystopian touch to it, and although it fits the story pretty well and I really enjoy a futuristic novel from time to time, I would have preferred for it to be mentioned in the description.
