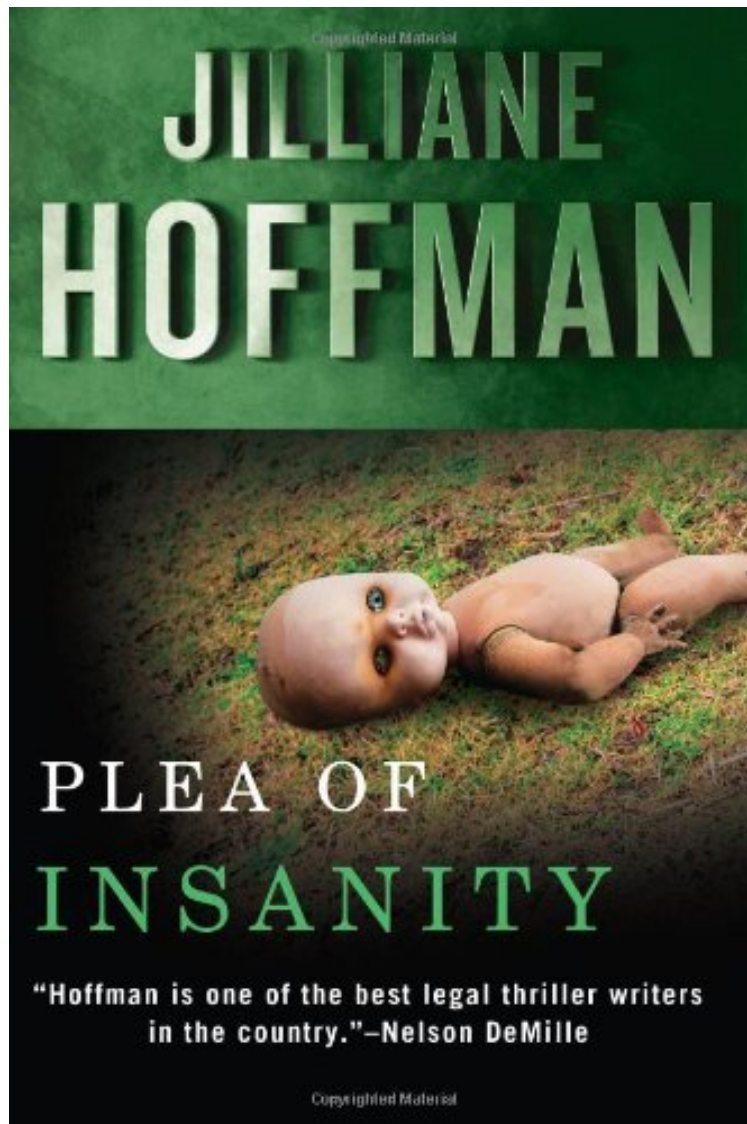

Leidet er an Schizophrenie oder beging er kaltbltig die Morde ?Aber wie war die Umsetzung ! Absolut langweilig, seitenweise wird einem das amerikanische,

oft aberwitzige Justizsystem vorgekaut, in allen langweiligen Einzelheiten. Die Hauptdarstellerin bleibt seltsam bla und hlzern, unglaubwrdig. Das ganze Buch ist mindestens 250 Seiten zu lang. Als Thriller kann man es sicher nicht bezeichnen, eher als Diskurs ber das amerikanische Justizsystem. Ich habe die englische Originalfassung gelesen, deshalb blieben mir zumindest die anscheinend deutschen bersetzungsfehler erspart. Aber alles in allem: Rausgeschmissenes Geld, eine groe Enttuschung, nicht empfehlenswert. 10 von 13 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. Thrilling, breathtaking and educating. Wow! Von Wombatsbooks After Hoffman's "Last Witness", which was just a shade above mediocre, her third thriller "Plea of Insanity" was a thrilling breathtaking surprise. Hoffman stated in her epilogue that she wanted to "pen a courtroom novel that was psychologically thrilling and [...] at the same time sympathetic [...]". She said that she wanted to entertain, but also to educate. In my opinion she passed with flying colors in all counts: Assistant State Attorney Julia Valenciano gets the chance of her life. She is asked to second-seat a high-profile case: Dr David Marquette is accused of having brutally bludgeoned to death his wife and their three children. His defense pleads not guilty for reasons of insanity whereas the aspiring State Attorney seeks the death penalty. Dr Marquette's defense attorney claims his client to be a schizophreniac. The aspiring State Attorney portrays him as a monster w/o a conscience. It is not only Julia's first major case, it is a case that is hitting too close to home and the skeleton's buried in Julia's family's closets. Therefore more than once she finds herself stuck between a rock and a hard place and caught up between sympathy for the defendant and questioning whether justice or whether political ambitions will be served... "Plea of Insanity" was indeed psychologically thrilling educating - very much so. It was also very sympathetic to those who suffer from schizophrenia. I learned lots of things, I never really thought about before reading this book. She also encourages readers to ponder the purpose of the death penalty. Therefore she also succeeded in making this book an educating one. Result: The saying goes that all good things come in threes. That's definitely true for Hoffman's third outing. Better than "Retribution" and by far more suspenseful than "Last Witness". "Plea of Insanity" is at least as good as Cornwell in her prime!
