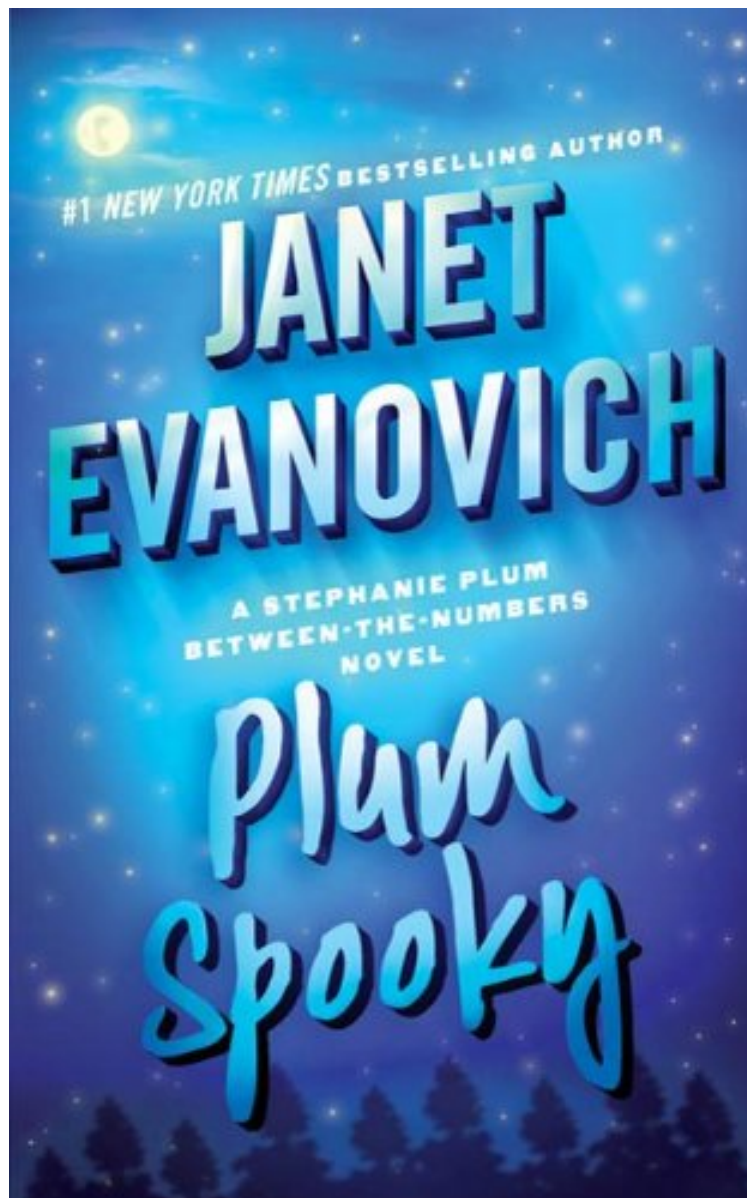

Fast die ganze Zeit ist Carl dabei, der Affe, den Stephanie, eher unfreiwillig, in Pflege genommen hat. Zu Dritt begeben sie sich auf die Jagd...Die Diesel-Romane aus der Stephanie-Plum-Reihe sind ja eher leicht "bernatrlch" (eben unmentionable :). Auch dieser flit wieder darunter, aber nach meinem Geschmack ist er nicht so bertrieben, wie die bisherigen Diesel-Romane. Wer allerdings auf die Morelli-Ranger-Stephanie-Aktionen hofft, muss sich hier leider mit Diesel zufriedengeben, da beide nur in Nebenrollen auftreten. Am besten gefllt mir Carl, ein kleiner nerviger Affe, der genau versteht, was um ihn herum passiert und dies auch auf seine Weise kommentiert. In the past, Between-the-Numbers Plums have been somewhat disappointing . . . with lots of Diesel (the now-you-see-him, now-you-don't spook who seems to be connected to The Men in Black), but little or no Morelli and Ranger. Well, Ms. Evanovich has solved that problem in Plum Spooky by putting in decent amounts of Morelli and Ranger to season the minor chemistry between Diesel and Stephanie. As a result, this is a full-fledged Plum . . . just as though it had its own number . . . you know, something like Frightening Fifteen. As usual, Diesel appears out of nowhere with no warning. Stephanie has three accused who have missed their court dates, and none of them seem to be particularly challenging. There's Gordo Bella who ran over his ex-wife's new husband twice and is otherwise law-abiding. Denny Guzzi shot himself in the foot while robbing a convenience store, so he probably isn't going to run very fast. The other is Martin Munch, a skinny, five-foot two-inch scientist who looks like a kid in a SpongeBob T-shirt. Now all that would seem pretty straightforward, but there's a complication. Susan Stitch has left her pet monkey, Carl, for Stephanie to baby sit while Susan is away on her honeymoon. You guessed it. Carl's part of the investigation team. Now, Carl's not your usual monkey. You'll have to read the book to understand what I mean, but it's all very funny. The story has one other complication. Have you ever read any of the Carl Hiaasen novels about cleaning up the creeps who are ruining the environment? Well, Carl Hiaasen could have been a coauthor for parts of this story as we read about the Pine Barrens in southern New Jersey and the mythical men and beasts of that area (including the Jersey Devil who flies noisily above the trees at night). Oh, and there's also a plot to control the world. Diesel has a cousin, Wulf Grimoire, who is partnered with Martin Munch to develop some pretty dangerous technology. Diesel claims that he needs Stephanie to join him so that Wulf will not be able to detect him. As you might expect, Stephanie is happy to help . . . but she's got to meet her other responsibilities, including those other skips, helping Morelli's brother, and advising women on how to handle their men. With so much at stake, you might not realize that there will be more fun than a barrel of monkeys (perhaps because there are lots of monkeys in the story). Lulu's love life takes an unexpected turn. And you'll meet one of the most dangerous characters ever . . . who has a most remarkable secret problem (that doesn't remain secret for long). This story is so off-the-wall you could almost imagine it ending with Stephanie waking up from a dream to be relieved that it's all over. But it's no dream, it's Plum Spooky. The only thing that's missing is some movement of Stephanie permanently toward one of the men in her life. Have a ball!

Bisher zeichneten sich die "Zwischennummern" der Stephanie-Plum-Krimis durch ihre Lckenfller-Qualitten aus: wenn man schon auf die neueste "ganze" Nummer warten mu, nimmt man eben mit einer Art Kurzgeschichte vorlieb, die eher bernatrlches ins Spiel bringt, und die Hauptpersonen mitbeinhaltet, ohne da es in der Rahmenhandlung, sprich Stephs Beziehung zu Morelli und Ranger, irgenwelche Fortschritte geben wrde. Anstatt der beiden Mnner teilt Diesel Stephanies Wohnung, Essen und Bett, eine Art Mischung aus "Buffy" und "Blade Runner", der seinem Cousin Wulf auf den Fersen ist, der gemeinsam mit einem spntinfantilen Quantenphysiker mittels einer Wettermaschine aus aufgetunten Raketen die Weltherrschaft an sich reiern mchte und nebenbei noch dessen Probleme mit Frauen durch Willensbeeinflussungsexperimente an Affen in den Griff bekommen mchte, als Dreingabe sozusagen. Wie man schon merkt, ist diese Story sogar fr einen "In-Between" reichlich abgefahren, diesmal allerdings im besten Sinne. Die abgedrehte Handlung wird mit spritzigem Humor garniert, die Gags und das Tempo sitzen, die kultigen Elemente wie z.B. da diverse Autos draufgehen bekommen eine neue, originelle Variante, die bestens zur Story pat. Der bernatrlche Aspekt erlaubt sich augenzwinkernde Anspielungen auf den Paranormal-/Vampir-Hype und ist damit weitaus treffender als Vorgnger, die sich mit kleinwchsigen Menschen und verkappten Weihnachtselfen den Humor herbeiqukten. Besser gelst als bisher ist auch die Einbeziehung der beiden anderen Mnner im Leben der Heldin, die nahtlos in die Handlung integriert ist. Wenn man nicht allzugenau darber nachdenkt, wie unwahrscheinlich einige Szenen sind, wie etwa, wenn Steph Morelli erzht, da ein nackter Mann (Diesel) unter ihrer Dusche steht, und dieser kaum darauf reagiert, wird man rundum bestens unterhalten bis zum Schlu. Fr mich vom Humor und Timing her einer der besten "Plums", der locker mit den

ganzen Nummern mithalten kann. Also: lesen!
