Surprisingly good! Von Benny I picked up *Poor Man's Fight* on a whim after I was out of reading material once more, thinking that the summary sounded vaguely interesting and that it might be a good way to pass the time waiting for one of the numerous sequels I'm desperately hoping for. While the prologue didn't convince me immediately, it was not off-putting either and gave a few crucial explanations about the world this is set in. The main character is fairly easy to identify with (doesn't everyone see themselves as a talented good guy? ;)) and is introduced in a familiar fashion, running somewhere because he's late (while I can't name them off the top of my head, more than one book starts just that way). While he is not revolutionary by any standard - some may consider him to be everyday fantasy/sci-fi cost - I found him to be both likeable and realistic enough. Someone criticized that he is not developed very well in the sense that he doesn't really make many decisions and is rather forced through unavoidable situations again and again - while that definitely holds some truth, it certainly didn't feel like that to me while I was reading it. The author really made him come to life for me and the odd humorous moment loosened things up to avoid the main character becoming a stereotypical action-hero - he also lacks the ruthlessness those usually have. Anyhow, I'm not really a big reviewer and find it hard to put into words why I liked this book so much. Let me try to summarize it: if you have at least a small affinity for Sci-Fi, like a fair bit of action in a book and are not repulsed by a main character that has a few super-hero characteristics, this is probably going to be an enjoyable book for you. It's not the most immersive or best thought-out setting of all time and is centered heavily on the protagonist, but it's very entertaining and more than just a way to pass the time.
