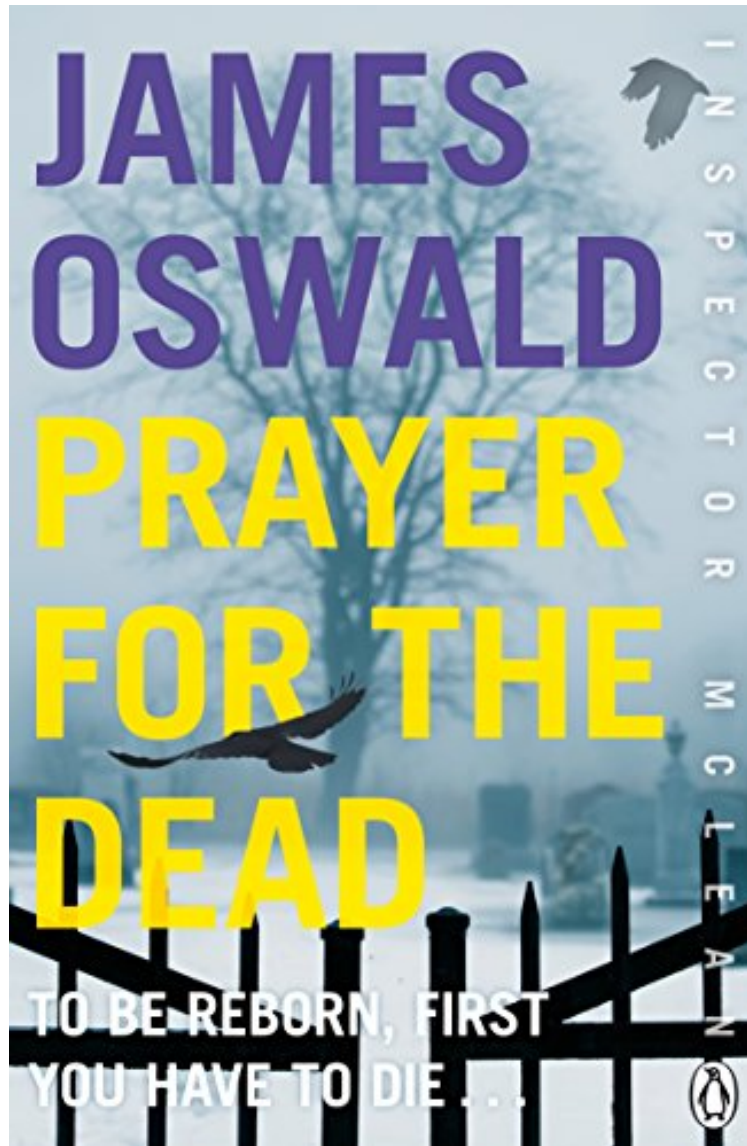

I think it was in the acknowledgements of one of his books, and as it looked like he was talking about a fellow crime writer, I looked him up. Boy was that a smart move! I don't know why, but I like Scottish writers, and James Oswald's no exception. Like the Inspector McLean novels before it is primarily a police procedure, but with supernatural overtures. I know this sounds strange, but funny enough, it works. I've not encountered anything like it before, but it had me hooked from the beginning. I don't want to spoil the story for you, so just a few words about it: A journalist goes missing and is then found dead; a journalist not very much liked by most of the police. And McLean not only has to deal with it, but he actually has to collaborate with Dalgliesh, a journalist he especially dislikes, which makes for interesting conflicts, and then the killer strikes again....
