However, it turns out that Hank Phillippi Ryan is a female ' an award-winning television reporter (not known to me in the UK) ' and she has clearly used much of her experience in her job to inform this book.Charlotte McNally is

a successful television reporter but she's now at that dodgy age (46) when she may be too old for the camera and her job might be at risk. She knows she's got to get a huge story for the November ratings so that she can be sure of employment for the following year - but will she find a story? The answer is yes. The story comes to her in dribs and drabs, beginning with the death of a man in a car accident and continuing through a series of strange spam emails, folders containing investment information about various companies, and a rather handsome schoolteacher. Charlotte and her producer Franklin are trying to work out if there is a story buried amongst all that ' and soon discover that being involved with this story could be very dangerous indeed. This was a good read. I liked Charlie and enjoyed the way the author explained her fears about her age and her job. Some of the other characters, such as the appalling Angela and the appealing Josh, were also good. The pace worked well for this novel and the insights into the life of a television reporter were interesting, although Charlotte seemed rather too 'nice' to be a media success to me. My one reservation was that I didn't quite understand all the threads of the plot, particularly with regard to the spam emails and investment situations.
