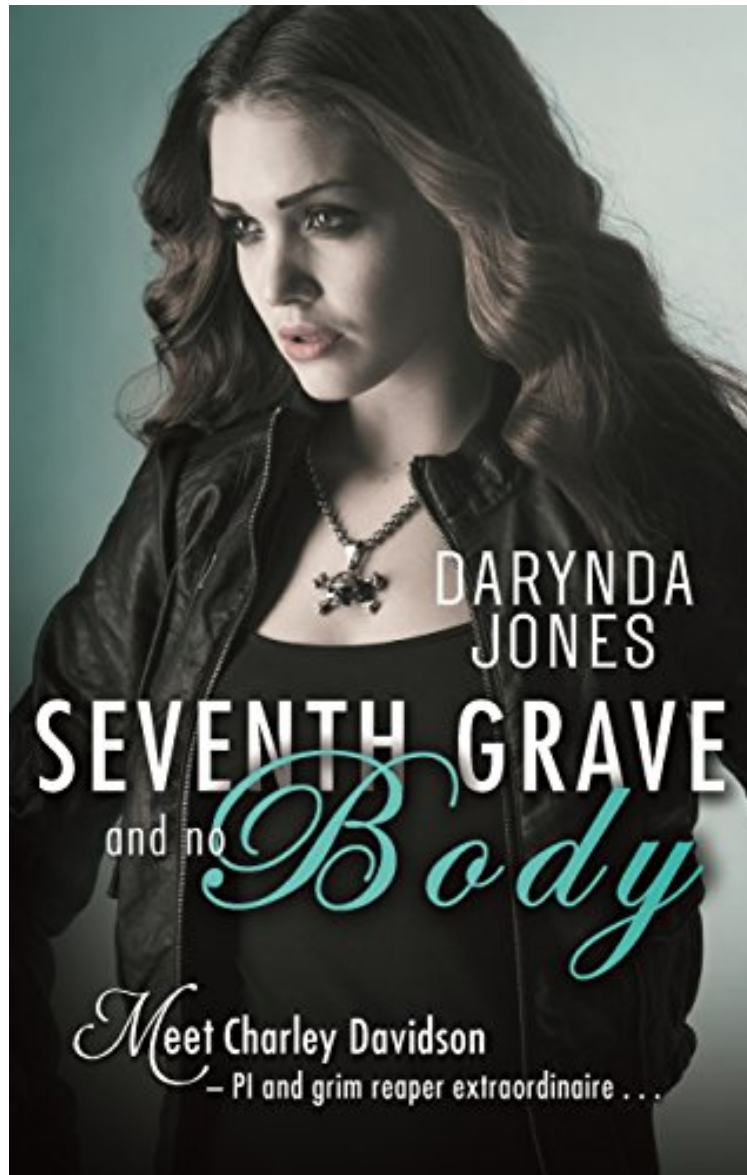

closes in on Charley Von Mina Note: this is installment no. seven in the Charley Davidson UF series and if you're new to it, there is not a chance to read this book and get into story, world and characters. The events in prior books are needful knowledge to understand Seventh Grave and no Body, so this is not a good place to start and in case you don't know the series, I strongly recommend to start with First Grave on the right. Review I'm grateful Charley shows less of the characteristics that bothered me in the last book: she is still reckless beyond measure and inappropriate funny most of the time, but not to the extent she was in book six. And the situation she and her unborn daughter are in, is more than a little disconcerting: it is confirmed that the twelve hellhounds have escaped hell and are effectively hunting her and their first encounter makes it devastatingly clear that the odds are against her, Reyes and their allies. Then there still is her predicted death, her name on Rocket's wall. I don't get how Charley can be so unconcerned by it. She fully trusts in the prophecy declaring her unborn daughter the one to confront Lucifer and deduces that she has to be alive at least long enough to give birth... okay... that is some kind of reasoning I don't totally get, but hey, I'm no grim reaper so what do I know. I have to give it to Charley, she isn't the person to let herself become gloomy or anything drag her down. She keeps her head high and this, combined with her sheer goodness and courage are what make her a heroine I like to read about. Again her cases aren't much more than side-stories and I get that Reyes and Osh the Daeva-Demon get angry at her for following leads when hellhounds they haven't figured out how to conquer yet, are so close on her heels. But then, as she says herself: it's her thing, it's what she does and cannot stop doing. And one of her cases that seems pretty inconspicuous at the beginning turns out to be something much more and it's very closely related to one of their pasts. The overall story arc about who and what Charley is, the prophecy and stuff, are explained a bit further, but I have to admit not as much as I would have liked it to. Yet, there undeniably is progress and Charley's ever and rapidly growing powers are a sure sign of it. Osh the Dealer is a great addition as a character and the Vatican's interest in Charley kind of gives me the creeps [yeah, not a catholic, obviously]. On a side note there is Charley's father's disappearance and when he reemerges it's a shock in more than one way, not that I'll spoil it. And I appreciated how the Jessica-occurrence is handled here. I may even have cried a few tears on one occasion. All in all, it's a good addition to the series and if you liked Charley so far, you'll very much like Seventh Grave and no Body.
