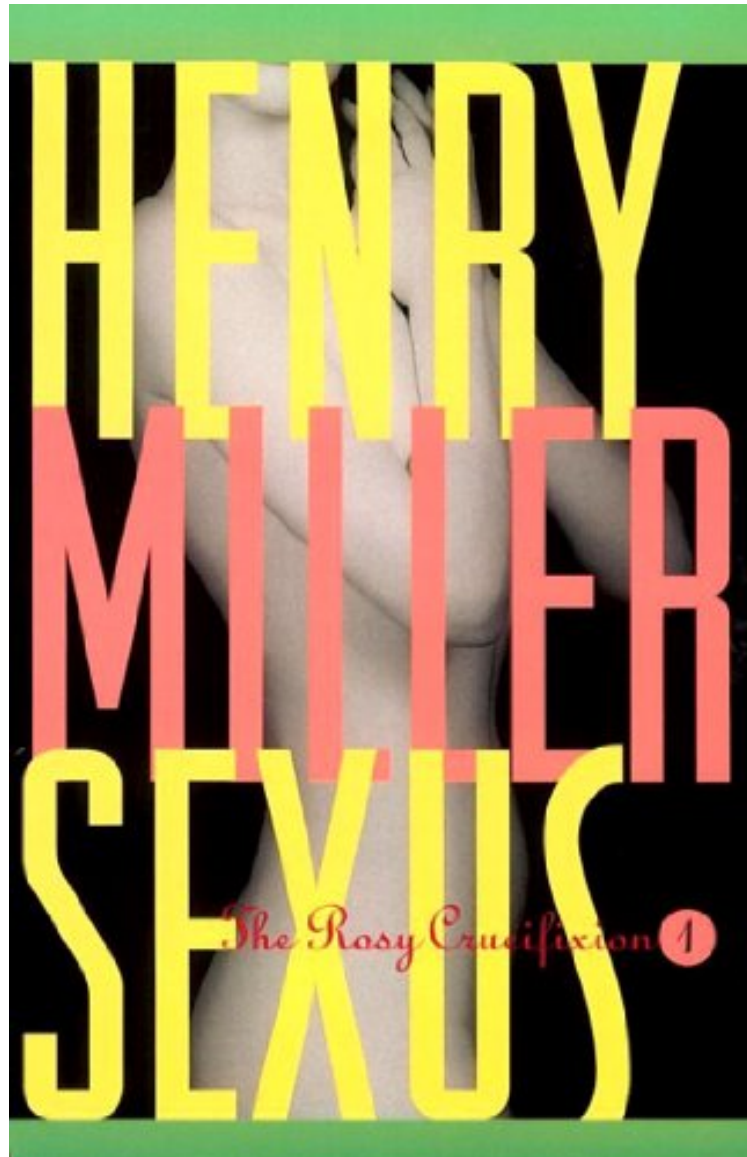

The events of the book center around his original meeting with Mara/Mona and from there

spiral outwards in many directions, gathering in a wide variety of bizarre and loveable characters, and showcasing Miller's unparalleled ear for language and gift for description. Yes, there is plenty of sex in *Sexus*, more so in fact than in any other Miller work. Yes, much of it can be dismissed as misogynistic chest-beating. The sexual passages are not sensuous or romantic or even erotic; they are satirical and in most cases hysterically funny. While some readers will of course be put off by graphic sex of any kind, those with flexible tastes are in for some good laughs, as well as virtuoso displays of first rate writing talent. "Dirty parts" aside, this vast ocean of a book tells a powerful story that is compulsively readable throughout. It is more accessible than the "Tropics" pieces, which are more surrealist and abstract; here Miller employs a much more straightforward narrative. This is probably one of the four or five most important works in English to be published in the 20th century (and is in many respects a repudiation of 19th century literature). He doesn't inhabit a different world to the one that I live in, but he views its colours and experiences much more richly and immediately. This is a text which should change your life and make open your eyes to the detail around you. The most wonderful aspect of Miller's story is that he is about to turn 33 at the novel's beginning. As he relates to the reader this is also a similar age to when Christ began his ministry: Miller's life built up to this time of fruition, riotous imagination and sensuous living. I am not particularly interested in reading Miller's other works, but I am glad I happened across this book in such an unlikely place and experienced the fascinating literary world of Mr. Miller. Kurzbeschreibung Henry Miller's monumental venture in self-revelation was begun with his *Tropic of Cancer* and *Tropic of Capricorn*, which on their American publication were hailed as "miraculous," "superb," "ribald," "brilliant," and "shamelessly shocking." *Sexus* is the first volume of a series called *The Rosy Crucifixion*, in which Miller completes his major life work. It was written in the United States during World War II, and first published in Paris in 1949. Of this remarkable project, Lawrence Durrell has said: "The completion of his seven-volume autobiography, if it fulfills the promise of what he has already given us, will put his name amongst the three or four great figures of the age."
