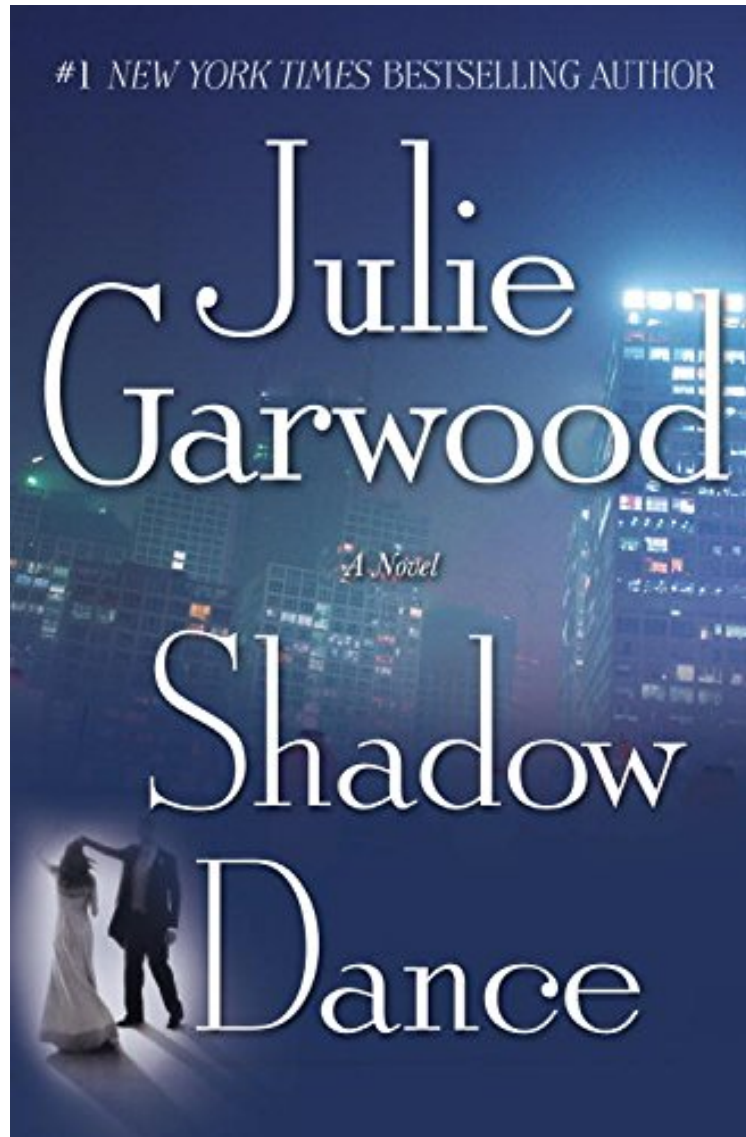

book is a romance and thriller at once. Von Alex PAdd in some contemporary shake, and you've got Shadow Dance. I rather liked that the title is a play on Jordan's father's situation (bodyguards shadowing his every step) inadvertently happening to her when she finds the dead body of a historian she's met two days prior in the trunk of her car and her brother Nick and Noah Clayborne, two FBI agents, fly at her aid. Hence, being shadowed by bodyguards of sort. Then Nick has to leave, for matters unknown, and suddenly begins a dance of should-shouldn'ts with Noah even as they try to find the real murderer, who proves to be one heck of a surprise. This is a great read, and I found it refreshing, witty and intelligent and less tedious than some of her previous works. The writing is fast-paced, which makes sense as this is a thriller as well, and Jordan and Noah's relationship does not bloom quite as suddenly as has been said. Re-reading through it, you'll find that Noah unknowingly had feelings WAY before they even began *cough* dancing. Anyway, hopefully we'll get to read more about Jordan and Noah and their treasure hunt! Thorough romance without thorough logic Von Sidney II normally adore Julie Garwood's romantic novels. She is very good at describing growing passion and attraction. She paces her story nicely and creates attractive, likable characters. Her main male characters are tall, muscular gentlemen: which female reader could resist them? Shadow dance has all these good ingredients, but the actual thriller part is somewhat illogical with plenty of lose ends at the end. The most pressing question remains: WHY did the killer need the papers? I also think the explanation why Professor MacKenna wrote the number 1284 in the margins of his research is feeble and unbelievable. And then Garwood chickens out in the end and never really tells us what it says in those papers. Had MacKenna really discovered anything? I did read this through in one go, and I did start reading it a second time round at a slower pace, which says a lot about Garwood's gripping style. I just wish she would be a more thorough writer, do better research and not give up on a logical plot too soon. Yes, we, her female fans, read the books for the romance, but not ONLY for the romance! Do credit us with some brains, too.
