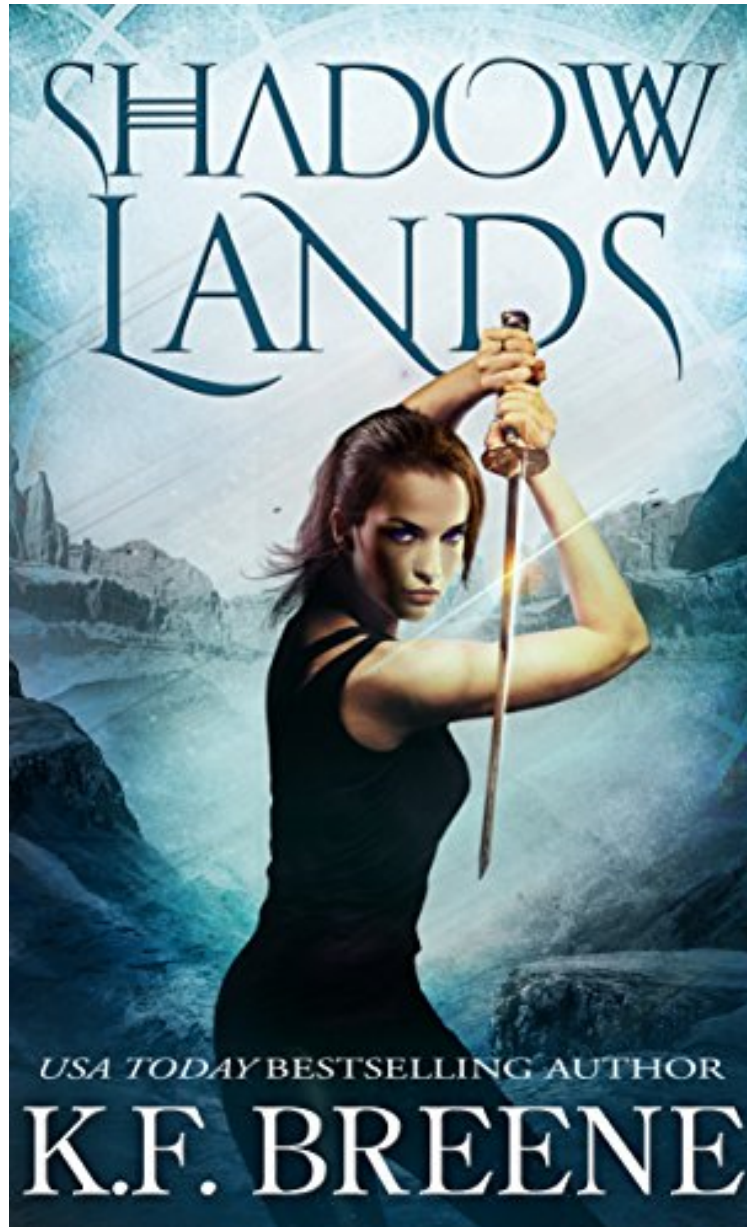

Therefore this is no good place to start reading. If I were new to The Warrior Chronicles, I'd start with Chosen. Review Finally the trials are here and K.F. Breene doesn't hold off on the action. The book starts right away with Shanti getting off the ship, leaving her friends and allies and going off to fight her way through the area where she is tested with everything nature, magic and warriors can throw at her. But although she really tries to do everything according to the Shadow people's rules, she is the exceptional person she used to be and things tend to turn messy and unprecedented stuff happens where she is concerned. Of course, the trials of all things aren't an exception to this rule: her trials are different from all that happened before [her being the first woman to try it only being the least]. Since there is Shanti in the trials and the rest of the gang in the village where more and more Graygual and Inkna are arriving, there are again two narratives happening parallel. And it's also various POVs that make it easy to follow everything that happens without feeling constructed. The introduction of the Shadow people widened the scope of the world and they really are kin to Shanti and Rhonan's people, they even look very much alike. And furthermore, they have a very similar societal structure: women fight and lead and everyone is judged and deployed according to capability, not according to sex. It was fun to see how Cayan's people have adjusted to women fighting through their contact with Shanti they've come a long way and now they're able to make fun about themselves and their former narrow view of gender roles [Again saved by a woman, I'll never hear the end of it...]. But besides from that and some progress in Shanti and Cayan's relationship, this is not a book about character development. This is a book that lays the ground for the [hopefully] final battle between Shanti, Cayan and evil warlord Xandre and that it does very well. The pacing is good, not overly on the action side, but there's always suspenseful stuff happening and K.F. Breene again shows how well her descriptions of battles are. I was a bit disappointed at first, because I thought that this was the last book and therefore expected the showdown. But although I did not get that, I got a very well written fantasy story about trials, overcoming someone's prejudices and stances and huge and satisfying fights and battles. And while the banter wasn't as impressive as in the prequels, it was there and made me smirk now and then, providing me with added entertainment. I'm waiting impatiently for the final chapter of these pretty cool Warrior Chronicles.
