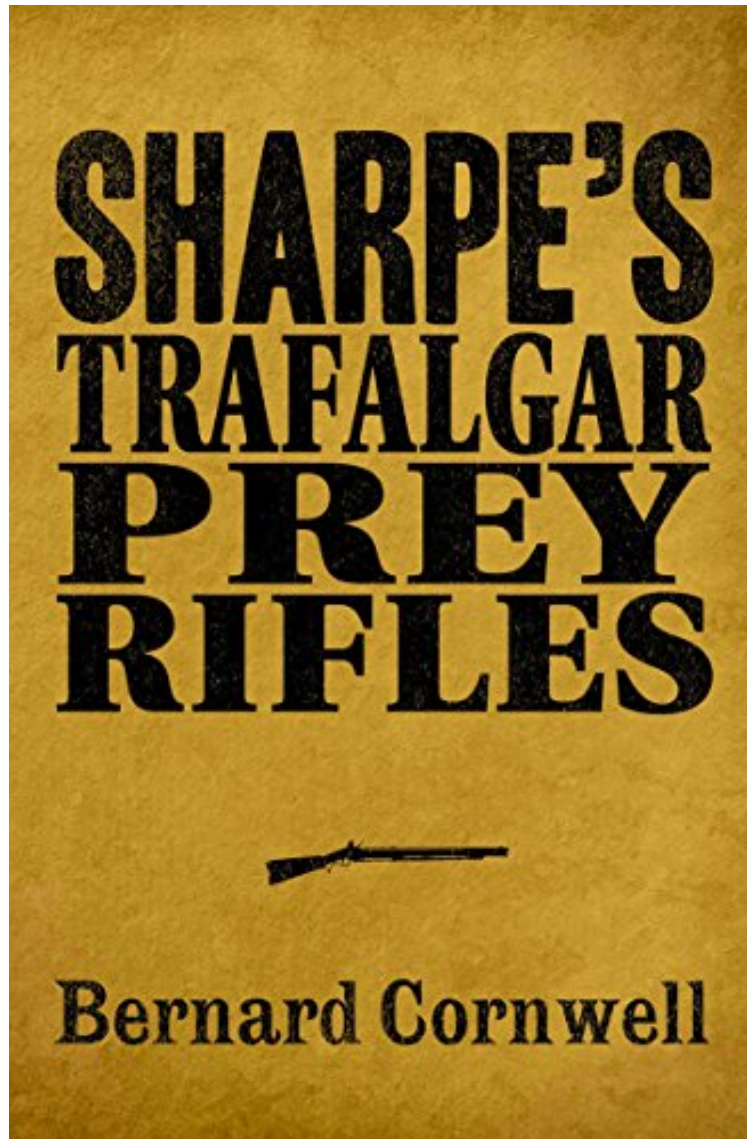

Bei Sharpe's Trafalgar hat mir das ungewohnte maritime Setting gefallen, welches ja deutlich von dem der meisten anderen Romane abweicht. Das Leben an Bord eines Schiffes, die Technik, Bewaffnung, etc. sind detailliert aber nachvollziehbar geschildert, so dass man, wie bei allen Romanen Cornwell's, nebenbei noch einiges lernt.
