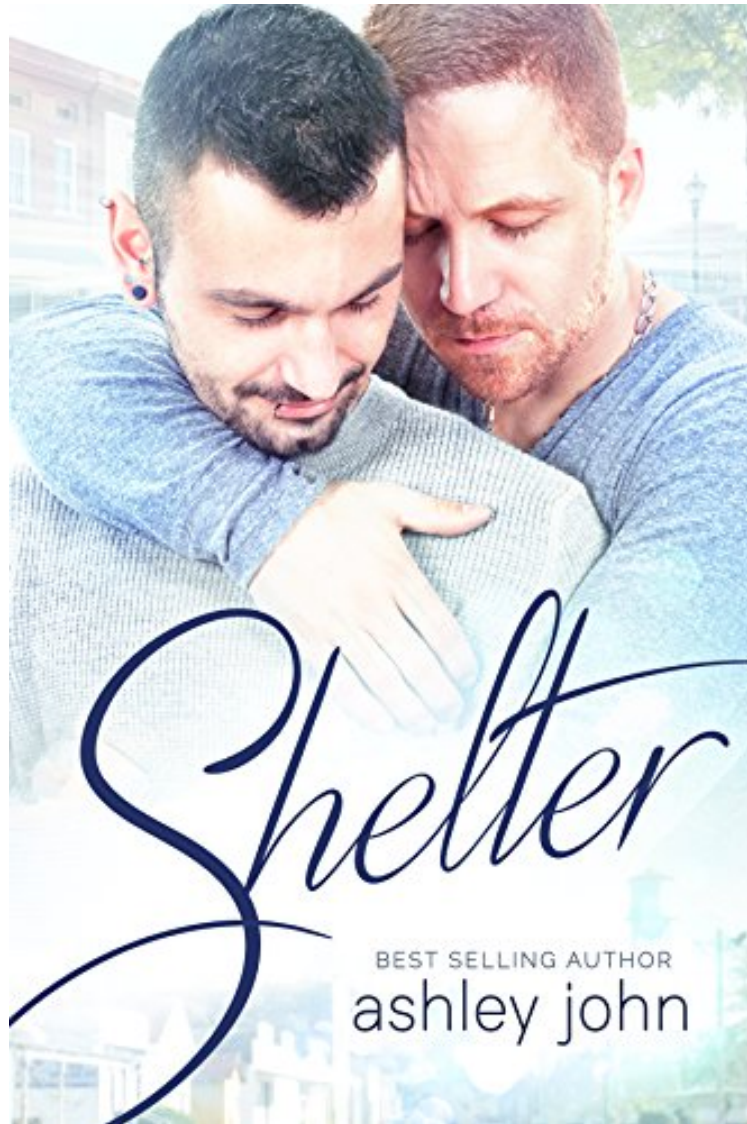

Shelter tells a story of the people whose paths happen to cross in this small town, and that incidentally involves a love story.The book features genuine characters who one can relate to,

with their individual aims and troubles, and who are gentle people generally but also take some stupid decisions at times. The story, consequently, is like life itself: sometimes you can see clearly where things are heading towards and yet it takes a few surprising turns in unexpected moments. I really enjoyed this book as it was more than a ready-set love story without any real plot but rather lets you feel people struggling with their individual decisions and events unfolding as individual characters make their moves. It's a nice and easy read that often leaves you with a smile on your face. My only point of criticism refers to the logic of one of the characters: it's unlikely that Elias' sister could have finished her course of studies, gained a reputation in her profession in town and raised a kid if she's supposed to be at his age. But hey, this is not a detective story! ;-)
