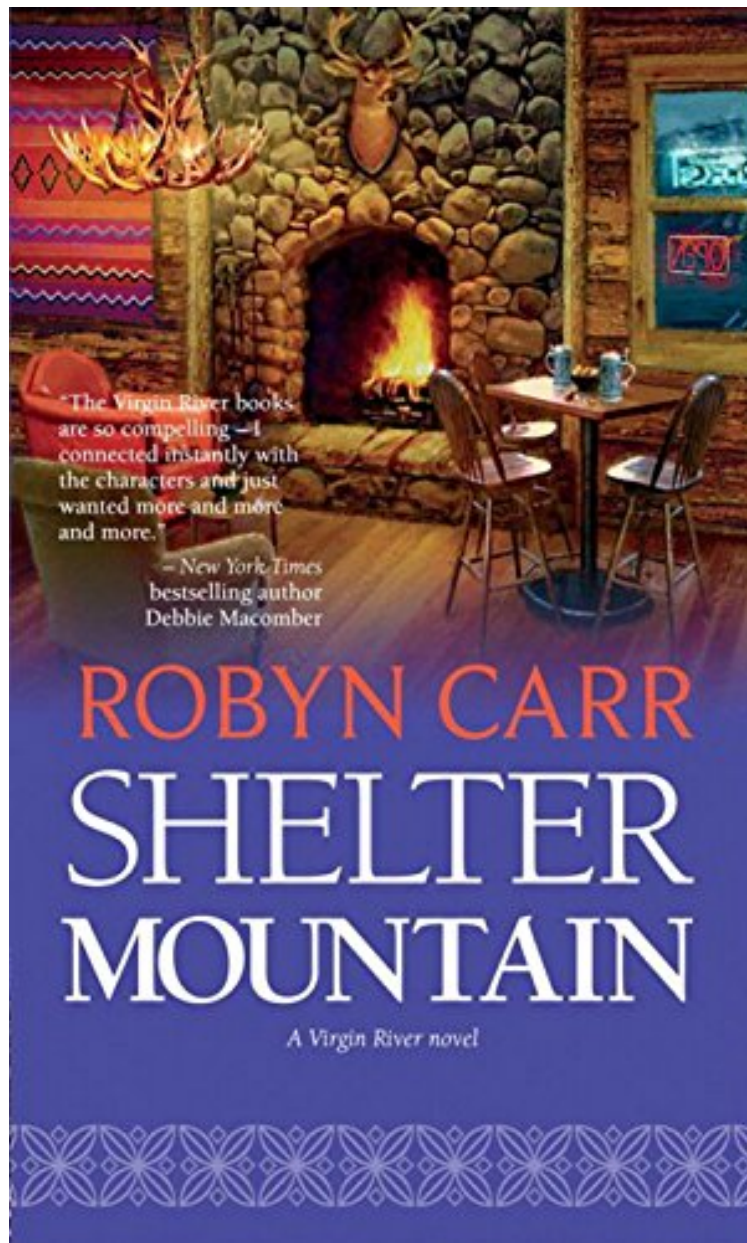

Eine Liebesgeschichte, die mich unterhält oder mitfühlen lässt, ist es nicht. Es war zu viel "in Watte packen". Warum John Paige attraktiv findet, bleibt für mich unklar; Funken fliegen zwischen den beiden nicht unbedingt.
