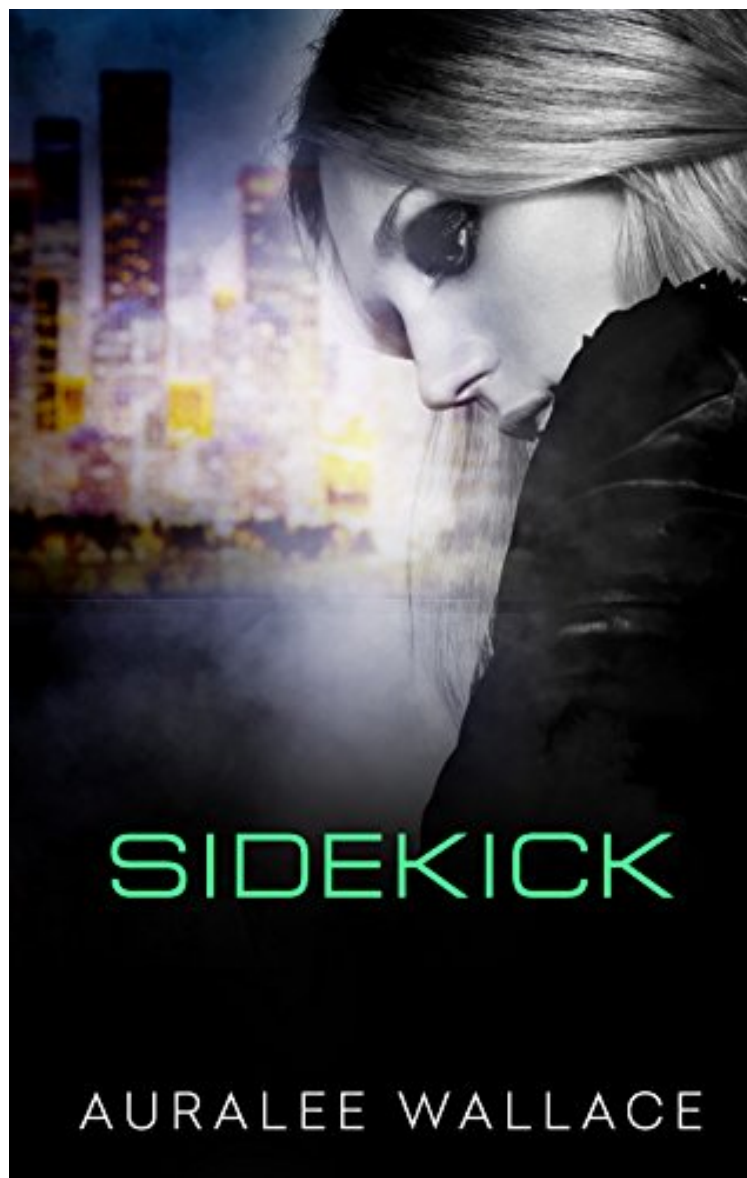

The most important feature of this novel is its humor. The author has a major talent there to create incredibly funny situations and lots of her dialogue is just reading-out-loud-to-random-people-hilarious. It's hard to describe the book's tone and atmosphere without quoting numerous parts of it though. But then, all this humor made the MC seem a little bit shallow. The book jumped right into the action without describing a lot of background and the greatest flaw of this book is the lack of characterization. I didn't really care for any of the characters. Some behaved like nobody would ever behave, especially in such a short time of knowing someone. Because the book is so short, there wasn't more time for people to get to know each other. The only one that I really liked was Pierce, he was just adorable. And the way he dealt with all the confusing things that happened whenever he was around Bremy just had me quietly chuckling all the time. A lot of times, I asked myself for more details. A fight between superhero and villain can't just be described like this: I watched spectacular blow after spectacular blow. That's just plain boring and doesn't satisfy my comic nerd needs.
