the 3rd person POV of Greyson Crawford, a guy camping nearby in the woods, who throws himself in front of the women he saves one woman and the baby and gets bitten and later on, turned into a were himself. Since this initial phase of the Change happens without him being conscious all the time, he doesn't know where the surviving woman went. Only that he can't forget her. This is the moment the plot could have become the usual and yeah, there is a lot Silver Wolf Clan has in common with the majority of PNR with weres: Greyson found his mate and wants her back, his Wolf and he both want to claim her, including the inevitable over-protectiveness and a lots of growling and snarling. But other than most werewolf PNR, the biggest part of the story is about how wrecked Grey's life has become, how hard it is for him to come to grips with his wild side. The author transmits a feeling of doom and gloom and pretty much hopelessness for Grey. His life gets better, if not really good, when he is found by the Dallas pack, who [mostly] help him get control over his Wolf. And because of the romance part, he meets the woman, Morgan, by chance prowling the city. Their connection is instant, but it was refreshing that they don't have the usual contrived obstacles and angsty misunderstandings, but instead are honest to a fault. I liked that about them. I'm not an insta-love-/mate-for-life-fan, but here it was done in a way I could live with. Probably because the characters feel real. Come to think of it, I wish I knew more about their life up until their fateful meeting during the were-attack. They both seem to carry some baggage and seem interestingly enough. There is not much going on on the outside, since this is really more a story about how people overcome dark and desperate times, and how they learn to connect to each other. The end was a bit abrupt and as I said, the book really could have done with more chapters.
