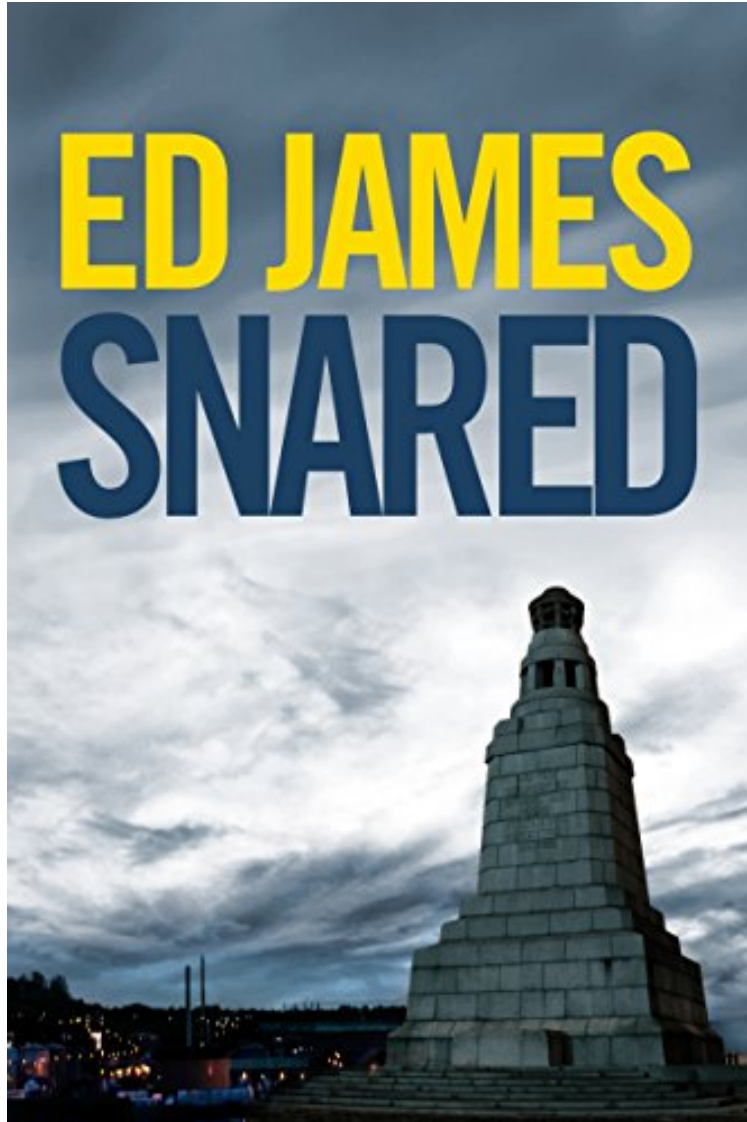

that immediately grabs your attention in a dangerously perverse fashion. It then continues to explore a murky underworld of murder, kidnapping and animal rights terrorism. In true Ed James style the novel continues smoothly with a marvelous attention to detail, to introduce further new characters and a plot that keeps the reader engrossed in a growing tangle of crimes that leaves you guessing all the way. The book is set in the east of Scotland, where I am fortunate enough to live and work and am very familiar with the areas of Dundee, Angus and the East of Fife. The research that has gone into the local area for the completion of this book is second to none.
