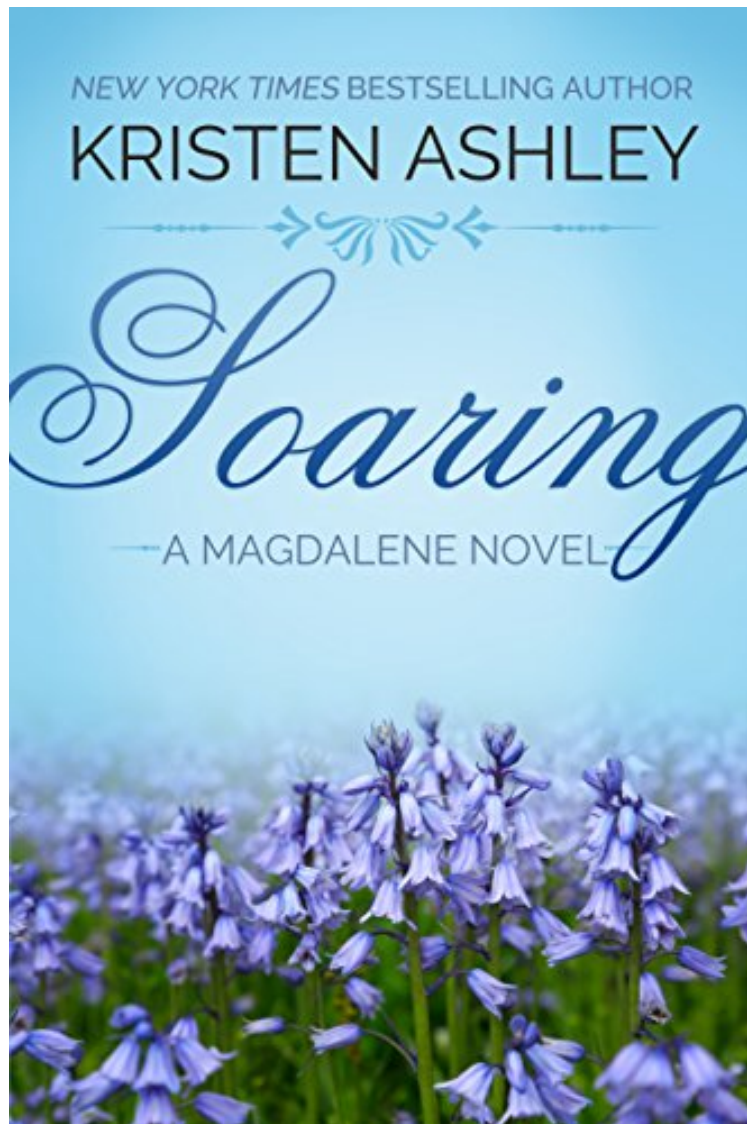

But the pacing was incredibly slow, during the first 20% nothing happened, there was a lot of boring inner monologue

and then the leading characters had some major flaws. I liked Mickey when he was first introduced in the book, but that didn't last very long. *****spoiler***** Mickey turned down a well paying job and future in the family business because he wanted to be a fireman and raise his family where he was raised. How does a supposedly strong (in mind and body) hero work for a dishonest boss for 15 years, especially when we later find out he is an heir to a fortune. Why didn't he start his own business earlier? His family is said to be close, so his father would have supported him. That did not sit well with me. He focused too much on the fact that Amelia was rich, and therefore, didn't need anything from him. Mickey's hot-cold attitude and insecurities about her wealth got on my nerves. I wonder if he ever would have chosen Amelia if he hadn't decided to cash in on his inheritance. I am not convinced he is comfortable having moved into Cliff Blue in the long run. He could rent it out and later hand it down to his kids.+++++End of Spoiler+++++ I appreciate a book with an older character in this case a 47 year old woman but was disappointed to read throughout the entire book that she didn't look her age, because she had the right clothes, expensive cosmetics, and her friend often took care of her few gray hairs by coloring it. There was too much emphasis on her wealth which she spent on her looks or the decorating of the house. Her working at the nursing home was an alibi, why didn't she get involved more with the junior boxing league? Mickey was just as flawless in regard to looks as Amelia. Working two jobs, looking after his kids, doing household chores and he had time for working out, training for boxing, really???? Even his day had just 24 hours. I know this is a novel, but a little realism would've been nice. Kids: I didn't understand the quick turn around in their feelings for their mom.
