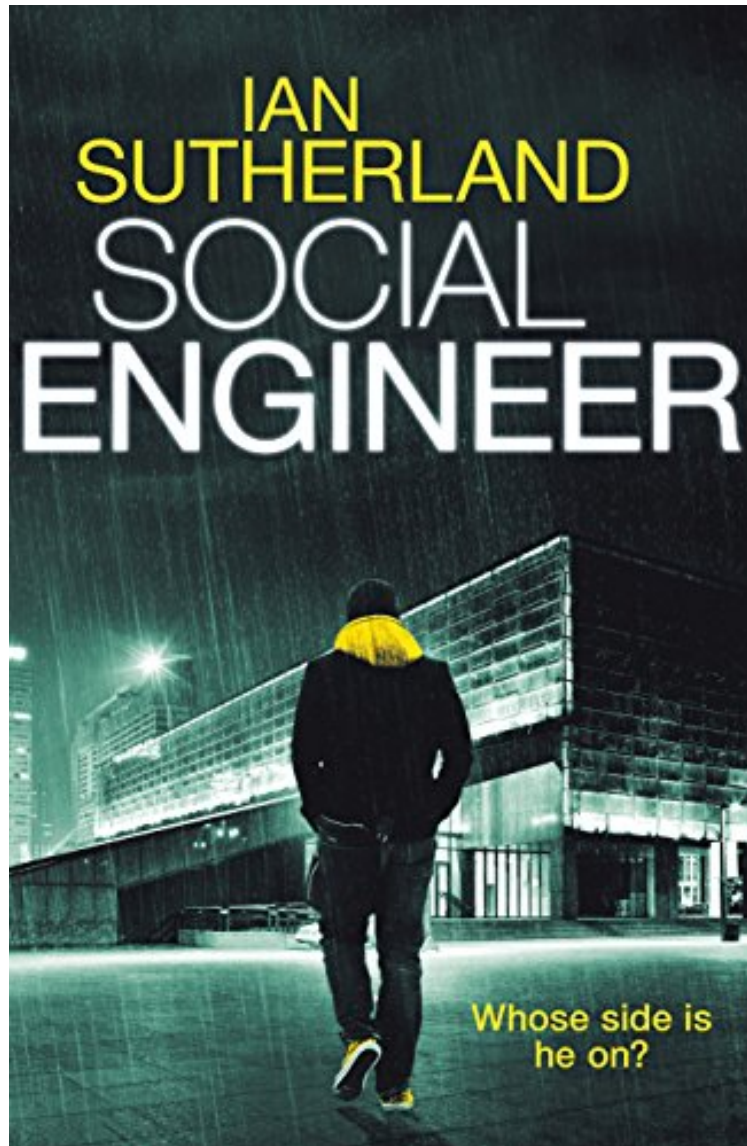

Brody Taylor is a white-hat hacker and is hired by a pharmaceutical company to "pen-test" their systems. The company believes they are under cyber-assault by the Chinese and Taylor is hired to see just how hard it is to break through. This is a short story which took me 45 minutes to read, and on the whole I really enjoyed it. But something felt off about the French girlfriend. A bit too cliched, a bit too "Allo, Allo" for my tastes. The ending also felt a bit of a downer and could have been improved a bit. Finally, the brief descriptive scenes of the terrified animals being experimented on at the company left me feeling a bit sick. I'm not naive, I know these things go on, but reading about it gives me nightmares. And the scenes described in the book are going to be in my mind for days now.
